COMPETITION DETAILS

1. Technical Committee Meeting

- 1.1 The Beach Volleyball Technical Committee Meeting will be held on Sunday, July 15th, 2018, 2.00pm at the Board Room, Yap Sports Complex.
- 1.2 The Technical Committee shall ensure that the Micronesian Games Beach Volleyball competition is conducted in accordance with the technical rules and regulations of the FIVB.
- 1.3 The Technical Committee shall consist of two representatives from the Host Country/Territory, one representative from each of the competing Countries/Territories and the head official for the competition, all with voting rights. The Technical Committee shall elect its own chairperson.

2. Maximum Entries

- 2.1 The maximum number of athletes per Country / Territory that may enter the Micronesian Games Beach Volleyball competition is one men's team and one women's team. Each team shall consist of two players and a coach/manager.
- 2.2 There are no substitutions or replacement of players in accordance with FIVB Beach Volleyball Rules.

3. Entries

- 3.1 All entries must comply with the entry requirements specified by the Micronesian Games Council.

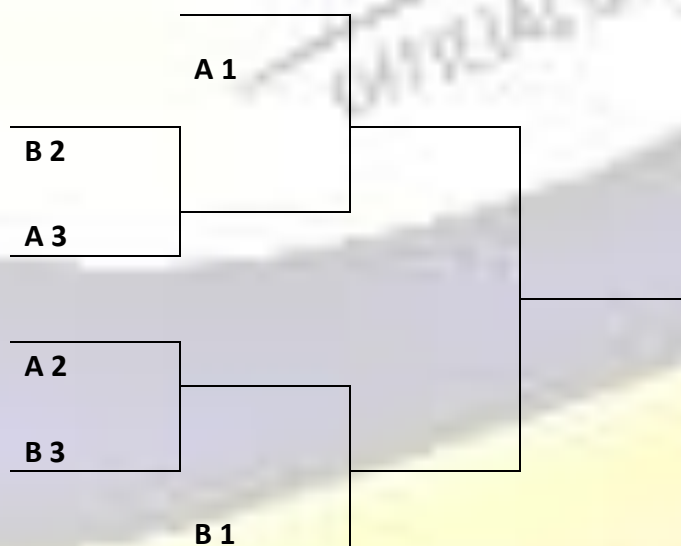
4. Competition format

4.1 The 2018 Micronesian Games Beach Volleyball Competition shall take place in both Men’s and Women’s Divisions following FIVB Rules. Since there are only five women teams registered in the games, teams will compete in a single round robin format, with the top two (1st and 2nd) teams advancing to the Gold Medal Match while the Bronze Medal Match will be between 3rd and 4th place.

4.2 The men have 6 teams and they will be in two pools with 3 teams in a pool. The pool will be determined from the ranking as follows:

Men Pool A	Men Pool B
1. Guam	2. Yap
4. Kiribati	3. Palau
5. CNMI	6. RMI

5. Competition Rules and Regulations

- 5.1 The Micronesian Games Beach Volleyball competition will be conducted in accordance with FIVB Rules and Regulations for Beach Volleyball.
- 5.2 The Micronesian Games Council shall have complete responsibility for the direction and control of the Games. The Technical Committee for Beach Volleyball shall have technical control of the organization of the event in accordance with FIVB Rules and Regulations.
- 5.3 In cases of disputes the Micronesian Games Council decision shall be final.

6. Registration

- 6.1 Registration will take place prior to each match of the competition at the Beach Volleyball Venue

7. Player's Equipment

- 7.1 Players shall be required to wear tank tops and shorts. Players may wear hats or visors and can wear glasses at their own risk.
- 7.2 Players' tank tops must be numbered 1 and 2. The number must be placed on the chest, center on back and/or on the front of the shorts. The numbers must be of contrasting color to the tank top or shorts. The numbers must be a minimum of 10cm in height and a minimum of 1.5cm wide.

8. Coin Toss

- 8.1 Before the official warm up, the first referee carries out a coin toss in the presence of the team captains. The winner of the coin toss chooses:
 - a). either the right to serve or receive the service or
 - b). the side of the court.
- 8.2 The loser takes the remaining choice. In the second set the loser of the coin toss will have the choice of (a) or (b).

9. Warm Up

9.1 Prior to the match the team will have a five-minute official warm up period at the net.

9.2 Teams must be at courts around 60 minutes prior to their match, 30 minutes at the warm-up court and can enter the main court for extra and official warmup after the previous match.

10. To win a match

10.1 The team that wins two sets wins the match.

10.2 In the case of a 1-1 tie the deciding set is played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points.

11. To Win a set

11.1 A set (except the deciding 3rd set) is won by the team that first scores 21 points with a minimum lead of 2 points. In case of a 20-20 tie, play is continued until a two-point lead is reached (22-20, 23-21 etc.).

11.2 Points System

Points will be scored as follows:

Win – 2 points

Loss – 1 point

Forfeit – 0 Point(s)

11.3 Default and Incomplete Team

- If a team refuses to play after being summoned to do so, it is declared in default and forfeits the match with the result 0-2 for the match and 0-21, 0-21 for the sets.
- A team that does not appear on the playing court on time is declared in default with the same result as listed above.
- A team is declared incomplete for the set or for the match loses the set or the match as both players of each team must always be in play. The opposing team is given the points, or the points and the sets needed to win the set or the match. The incomplete team keeps its points and sets.

12. Time outs and Technical Time outs

- 12.1 Each may request a maximum of one time-out per set.
- 11.2 Time-out request must only be made by the captain by showing the corresponding hand signal, when the ball is out of play and before the whistle of service. All requested time-outs last 30 seconds.
- 11.3 In sets 1 and 2 one additional time-out “Technical Time Out” is applied automatically when the sum of the points scored the teams equals 21 points
- In the deciding (3rd) set there are no “Technical Time Out”; only one time-out of 30 seconds duration may be requested by each team.
 - During all time-outs, Technical Time Out and set intervals, all players must go to the designated players’ area.

13. Coaching

- Coaching in Beach Volleyball is not allowed during a match. Coaches are not allowed on the Field of Play in accordance with FIVB rules. Repeated coaching may be penalized by the Technical Committee.

14. Facilities at the Venue

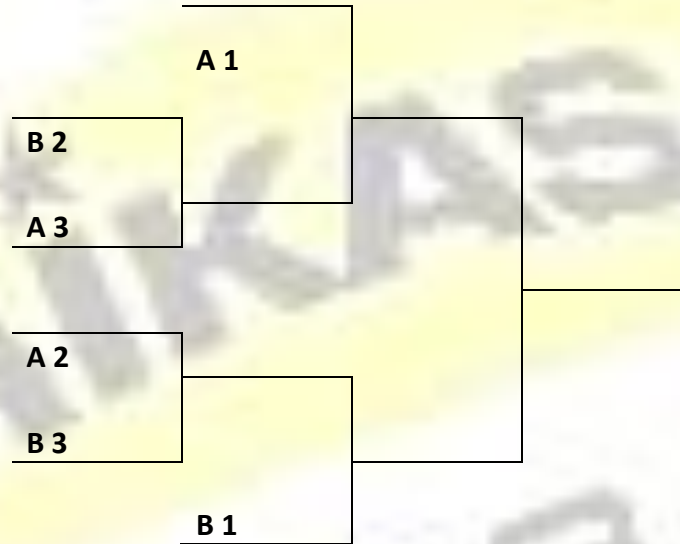
- 13.1 One practice court and the main court will be available for practice based on teams needs. Please contact the Tournament Director to schedule times.
